### Dues for 2012

Payment of annual dues is to be made by each member NLT January 1st of the dues year. As of the writing of this newsletter, 35 members have not paid their 2012 dues. The Secretary is required by The Code to notify individually by March 1st all dues-delinquent members of their delinquency. Postage

expense alone to the Lodge to make these notifications will be \$15.75(approximately 19% of the \$83 the Lodge has available from one member's dues). If you have not yet paid your 2012 dues, please do so immediately, because the notices will be sent out by February 27th.

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### Facilities and Maintenance Activity

(1) WBs Darrell Cline, Bobby Burgess, Bill Moss, and Larry Robbins(who furnished some sealant) spent several hours re-securing the exhaust vent hood to the roof, and inspecting the roof for what will be needed to properly secure the current metal covering on the roof. They secured and sealed the exhaust vent, and are now waiting, not only to see what effect—if any—their work has had on the leak, but also to see how the sealant they used holds up to rooftop winter cold

and summer heat. (2) With some assistance from WB Darrell Cline, WB Bobby Burgess completed the installation of the audio/visual upgrade equipment. Great job! (3) WBs Darrell Cline, Bobby Burgess and Bill Moss have the new back door ramp construction ready for concrete—hoping to get some leftover from other local area construction.
